Senate President Sharon Carson Statement on Democrats' Income Tax Scheme

CONCORD, NH – Senate President Sharon Carson (R-Londonderry) calls out Democrats for their income tax scheme. Republicans will continue to hold the line for New Hampshire families:

“Last month, Senate Democrats wanted to spend another \$1 billion while claiming it wouldn’t require raising taxes. Now we see where the money would come from. Democrats are pushing for a statewide income tax and an increase in property taxes.

Let’s be clear: the answer is no. We will not support higher taxes on New Hampshire families, or out-of-control spending that will force us into a broad-based tax.

They claim they want to ‘put more money in people’s pockets’, but what they really mean is their own. We don’t have to look far to know that higher taxes don’t help working families get ahead—they drive them out the door.”
