Senator Lang Statement on the passage of CACR 12

CONCORD, NH – Senator Tim Lang (R-Sanbornton) released the following statement after CACR 12, relative to voting on broad-based taxes, passed 16-8 today:

“Senate Democrats have already voted this year for well over a billion in new state spending with no way to pay for it. House Democrats have tried to pass another Billion in new spending. They are pushing New Hampshire to an income tax. This constitutional amendment would give Granite State voters a chance to weigh in on Democrats tax-and-spend agenda by requiring a supermajority vote of the legislature of New Hampshire to adopt a broad-based tax. Naturally, Democrats do not want voters to get that chance.”
